Basic Authentication in /Ubuntu Apache

Create the folder BASite within /var/www/html

With the /var/www/html/BASite folder create the file BAPage.html with s ome appropriate content, e.g.,

<html> <body>This is Schultz's Ubuntu site page with basic authentication!</bdy> </html>

At this point you should be able to access the web page using http://localhost/BASite/BAPage.html

Use

htpasswd -c /etc/users BAUser to create user & password which can be allowed access (the choice of a file users in folder etc was arbitrary)

Add a file named .htaccess to the /var/www/html/BASite folder with the following content:

AuthUserFile /etc/users AuthName "Authorization Required" AuthType Basic require valid-user

Finally, change /etc/apache2/apache2.conf so the section about <Directory /var/www/> looks like the following:

<Directory /var/www/>
Options Indexes FollowSymLinks
AllowOverride All
Order allow,deny
allow from all
</Directory>
